At the University of North Alabama, I hold multiple records on the golf team, including the program's first individual win, the best scoring average in school history, the most top-10 finishes, and the distinction of being the first and only golfer to earn ASUN postseason honors.

2024 – 2025 Season:

- Named ASUN Golfer of the Week
- Competed in all 10 events, securing 3 top-10 finishes
- Recorded a low round of 70 at multiple tournaments
- Best finish: Runners up at JSU Invitational and 6th at the Mercer Invitational

2023 – 2024 Season:

- Named to the ASUN All-Conference Third Team
- Competed in all 11 events, securing 6 top-10 finishes
- Recorded a low round of 72 at multiple tournaments
